



Dear Potential Embryo Donor:

Hopefully your fertility treatments have been successful and your family is complete. If you have embryos remaining in frozen storage, several options exist, including the donation of embryos to another infertile couple. The enclosed information reviews our embryo donation program.

Many infertile patients are *not* candidates for routine IVF procedures. Perhaps they have had ovaries removed or have undergone multiple IVF procedures without success. The egg donation program, although highly successful, is costly when compared to embryo donation. Embryo donation may be utilized by long-term infertile couples who have exhausted all other fertility alternatives.

Potential embryo recipients often have completed multiple IVF procedures or have a physical reason as to why they cannot proceed with standard treatments. Often times, the embryo donation recipient has undergone years of fertility treatments without success. The supply of donated embryos is limited and waiting lists can be long. Should embryo donation alternative be right for you, you will be helping a needy, appreciative patient.

Any patient who has cryopreserved embryos in storage may choose to donate these embryos to other needy patients. There is *no* cost to the donating couple, although a blood draw needs to be performed and a medical health history needs to be completed.

We thank you in advance for your generosity. Hopefully, you will be able to offer the gift of life to a less fortunate couple.
